- Tax Levy is 0%
- Administrative Cap is applied
 Can be no more than 7.84%
- Board of Education determines what is a contingent expense.

Under the proposed budget of \$25,972,698 the projected True Value Tax Rate is \$9.58* per \$1,000 assessed value.

Above estimates are based on the 2023 Tentative Tax assessments and assume 100% equalization rates and no change in taxable assessed valuation of the property, final tax rates will be available in August 2023.
