As a reminder of a few important items, please read the following information.

- #1) Access to Google Classes Students should check their schedules and then find the access they need for each teacher's Google Classroom. If you still do not have access to your child(ren's) schedule, please contact our Guidance Department immediately. Additionally, students should also check their school email as invitations to join the classes should have also been sent out. Please be sure to check back again tomorrow for invitations as well.
- #2) Book/Supply Pickup Tomorrow, September 9, from 3:30-6:30PM, some staff and I will be present to distribute textbooks, iPads (if an iPad is needed this is a small number of students), and other supplies. Again, in an effort to maintain social distancing guidelines, we have broken down pickup times based upon the first letter of your child(ren's) last name. *PLEASE MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO COME OUT TO EBIS TOMORROW USING THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:*

For students whose last name is A-C, please come between 3:30-4:00PM. For students whose last name is D-H, please come between 4:00-4:30PM. For students whose last name is I-M, please come between 4:30-5:00PM. For students whose last name is N-R, please come between 5:00-5:30PM. For students whose last name is S-U, please come between 5:30-6:00PM. For students whose last names is V-Z, please come between 6:00-6:30PM.

Also, please note that because we are beginning the year with remote learning, not all teachers have issued supply requests for students. Teachers are in the process of updating their individual webpages to include supply requirements, however, with students working from home, the list of items is not as extensive as previous school years.
