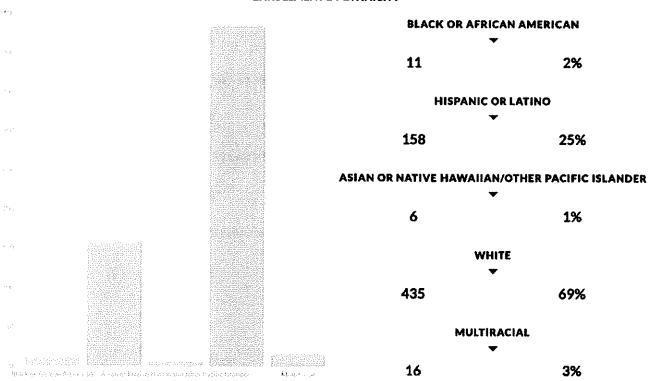

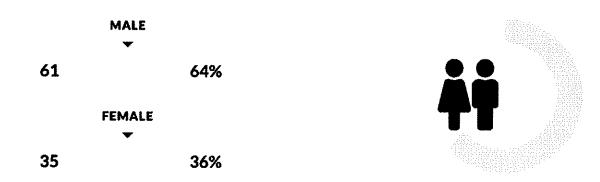
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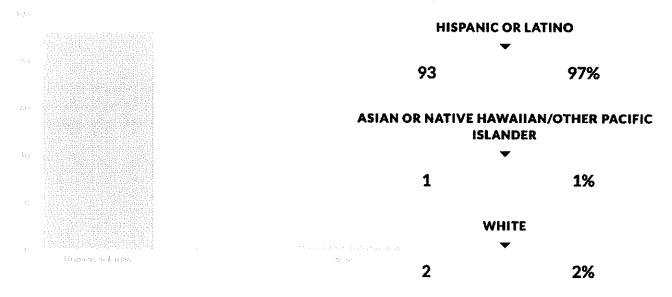
NORTHEAST CSD ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS ENROLLMENT (2019 - 20)

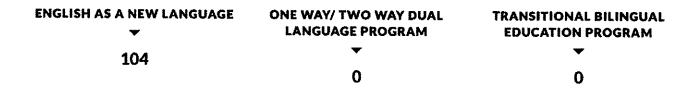
