Dear Webutuck Families,

I write this letter to inform you about a new safety procedure regarding traffic patterns at our EBIS/WHS facility. The District is making a few changes to the pattern after we reviewed a number of inquiries regarding student drop off/pick up at WHS and EBIS. In our never ending pursuit to provide the safest possible campus for our students and staff, the District will be implementing this procedure Monday, March 11, 2019.

A summary of the changes are as follows:

- school grounds speed limit is 10 mph which will be enforced by the Dutchess County Sheriff's Office;
- drop off/pick up will now be in the upper parking lot across from the tennis courts;
- students are no longer able to be dropped off / picked up in the back of the building;
- students should exit/enter vehicles on passenger side;
- students are not to exit/enter vehicle in the passing lane
- student drop off/ pick up lane is closest to sidewalk
- vehicles that have dropped off / picked up their student may use passing lane to the left of the drop off/pick up lane and must yield to vehicles in drop off/pick up lane upon exiting the loop;
- at drop off *only* the first five vehicles will be able to unload students, once they unload they will exit and then the next five vehicles will pull up to unload;
- A map of the new pattern accompanies this letter.

This summer the District will have arrows and center lines painted as well as signage placed in order to have more visuals for drivers. The remainder of this year, staff and cones will be placed appropriately to remind vehicles of the new pattern.

Again, these changes are for the safety of ALL that visit, attend, and work at the Webutuck Central School District. If you have a question or concern, please contact me at (845) 377-4100 X5506.

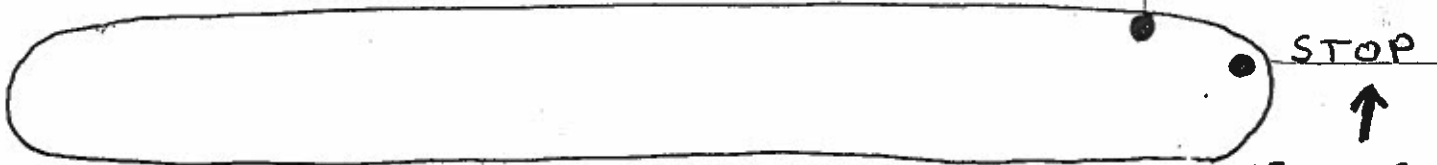
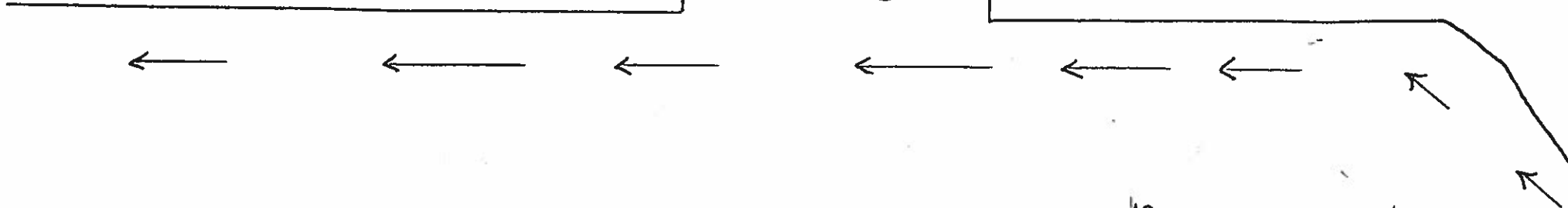
