

## **Summer Parent Survey Results (continued)**

The summer parent survey that we sent out provided us with a snapshot of some of the opinions and feelings that parents/caregivers have of Webutuck High School. We are using this feedback to guide the positive changes we are making. The data on the first page of the newsletter are simple percentages of positive, negative, and neutral responses. In addition, we have included some of the answers to open ended opinion questions.

- "There should be more opportunities for extra curricular activities other than sports (ex: peer mediation, chess club, art club, music club, etc). The electives (ex: piano class, criminal justice class, photography class, etc) that are offered during the school day are amazing and my children enjoy them, but often they don't fit into their schedule or they don't get the elective they really wanted."
- "1. You should offer more higher level elective choices, 2. we need better scheduling so students don't have to give up lunch to take band etc .. 3. We need more intramural choices after school ."
- "We should Increase positivity, Increase spirit and morale, and Increase pride in community."
