Our Community

The North East (Webutuck) Central School District provides quality education for students in pre-kindergarten through 12th grades for the towns of Amenia, Northeast, Ancram, Washington, Dover, Stanford, and the village of Millerton. The district is around 90 miles north of New York City and about 30 miles east of Poughkeepsie in what is known as Harlem Valley. Harlem Valley is home to historic sites, cultural opportunities, beautiful rural scenery, and several educational opportunities.

The vision of the North East (Webutuck) Central School District is that all students will acquire the knowledge, desire, and ability to attain their potential and make a significant contribution to society. Academic Information:

Grading System:

A numerical system is used for grading with 65% being the passing grade.

Rank in Class:

Weighted school averages are used to establish rank in class and include all courses except Physical Education. Class rank is calculated at the end of 11th grade. At the end of semester one for grade 12, rank is re-calculated to include the first semester grades for all courses except PE.

Courses are weighted as follows:

Dutchess Community College Courses: 20%

Honors Courses: 10%

Recognition is given each marking period (4 times a year) to students who meet the following academic standards:
