


One Book One School Summer Reading Challenge!

A Book Mobile

Create a mobile from items related to the story.

Select 10 items that represent people, places, events, or other parts of the book and hang them from a hanger using string or yarn.



Create a Collage!

Create a collage on large paper that represents the book. Your collage should have at least 10 pictures or illustrations. Try to add words cut from magazines or newspapers to make your collage interesting.

Pack your Bags



Imagine you are going to take a trip into the story! Pack a paper grocery bag with 10 items you would need to bring with you on your trip.


Can You See the Future?

Vocabulary Word Search


